All dogs using the play service must undertake an initial assessment which costs just \$30 dollars, together with having valid certificates of vaccination. With this in place, individuals living in the Dandenongs or other high risk areas can have a safe refuge for their dog, which can accommodate up to 90 canines in a safe, stimulating and social environment.

The center recommends that individuals have their initial assessment done before the next bushfire danger day, as trying to get the assessment and check in on the same day can be overwhelming due to the sudden spike in demand.
